The curriculum has been vetted by Center of Academic Excellence (CAE) in Cybersecurity colleges and universities and was created and mapped to the National Cryptologic Foundation Cybersecurity Curriculum Guidelines and CAE Cybersecurity Foundational Knowledge Units.
