

At NMSU Alamogordo, a student majoring in Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Intermediate might take the following introductory courses in Computer Science (CS) and Electronics Technology (ET):

Computer Science (CS)

1. **CS 1110: Introduction to Computer Science** - Basic principles of computer science, including problem-solving techniques and programming concepts.
2. **CS 120: Computer Applications** - Fundamental computer skills and applications, often including word processing, spreadsheets, and databases.

Electronics Technology (ET)

1. **ET 110: Introduction to Electronics** - Basic electronics principles, including circuit theory, components, and measurement techniques.
2. **ET 120: Digital Electronics** - Fundamentals of digital circuits, logic gates, and digital systems.
