Assistive Technology Specialist: Assists in developing and implementing technology solutions to help students with disabilities learn effectively. *Average salary:* \$60,000.

Classroom Teacher: Utilizes technology to enhance teaching and engage students through various digital tools and resources. *Average salary:* \$70,000



Curriculum Developer: Integrates technology into curriculum design to create engaging, interactive learning experiences. *Average salary:* \$68,000.

E-learning Developer: Designs, develops, and implements online courses and digital learning content. *Average salary:* \$70,000.

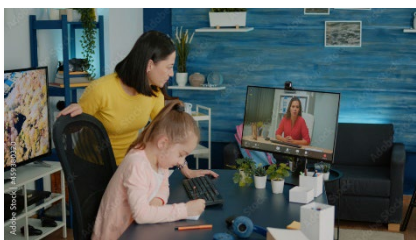
Gamification Specialist: Uses game-design elements and principles to create engaging educational experiences and enhance learning outcomes. *Average salary:* \$70,000.
