

15 Jobs in the **Food Industry** that Use Technology (there's more!)

Culinary Technologist: Combines culinary arts with food technology to develop new recipes and products. Average salary: \$55,000.

Digital Menu Designer: Uses digital tools and technology to create and manage electronic menus for restaurants and food services. Average salary: \$48,000.

E-commerce Food Manager: Oversees online food sales, using technology to manage websites, online orders, and digital marketing. Average salary: \$70,000.



Food Blockchain Specialist: Manages blockchain technology to track and authenticate food products throughout the supply chain. Average salary: \$80,000.

Food Data Analyst: Analyzes data to predict trends, improve processes, and optimize food production using technology. Average salary: \$68,000.
